Ladies and Gentlemen,


Welcome to the 13th Congress on Central and Eastern Europe, which traditionally takes place within the framework of the EURO FINANCE WEEK.

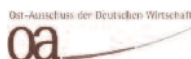
