EURONEST serves as a key interparliamentary platform for fostering dialogue between the European Union and the Eastern Partnership countries.

This side event will adopt a "Policy Meets Business" approach, convening Members of Parliament, policy experts, and business leaders to explore topics such as economic resilience, innovation, regional cooperation, and youth empowerment in the countries of Eastern Partnership, such as Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine. The initiative aims to identify common strategies for politics and business actors in order to foster an economic model in Armenia and across the region based on principles of diversification, sustainability and resilience and aiming at public wisdom and prosperity.

- Promote public-private dialogue within the EURONEST platform.
- Highlight opportunities for EU–Armenia cooperation under CEPA and the EU Green Deal.
