





**POPULATION** (million people)










#### **Unemployment rate (%)**








#### **UNEMPLOYED CITIZENS TRAINED FOR PROFESSIONS IN 2022**









#### CENTERS FOR TRAINING QUALIFIED SPECIALISTS IN THE FIELD OF CONSTRUCTION



Since April 1, 2022, centers for training qualified specialists in the field of construction have been established in 13 regions of Uzbekistan.

Unemployed citizens are being trained as construction professionals to work in local construction companies and abroad in these centers.

In the centers, citizens are also taught a foreign language, traditions and laws of the country in which the employee intends to carry out work.

### SERVICES OF FOREIGN REPRESENTATIVE OFFICES

In 2022, legal, material and social assistance was provided to 308.8 thousand migrant workers in foreign countries.



One-time material assistance of \$72 000 to 1 424 people 285 homeless people are housed in hostels \$ 5 350 of medical expenses were reimbursed to 7 citizens 1 397 citizens in difficult life situations were returned



1 086 citizens were released from forced labor
695 people received legal assistance in obtaining permission to return to their homeland
2 589 people were paid salaries, compensation and insurance amounting to \$1 199 700
9 600 other legal services provided
