

The German – Azerbaijani Connectivity Conference: Mobilizing Finance for Infrastructure, Transport, Logistics, Green Energy, and Digitalization along the Middle Corridor."

The German–Azerbaijani Connectivity Conference has been AHK Azerbaijan’s flagship annual event since 2025, providing a high-level platform for dialogue between German and Azerbaijani businesses, policymakers, and international financial institutions. The Conference brings together key stakeholders to discuss strategic economic priorities, business opportunities, and the practical requirements for advancing projects with relevance for Azerbaijan and the wider region.

The 2026 edition will focus on Connectivity along the Middle Corridor, addressing four key areas that are central to the Corridor’s further development: logistics, infrastructure, digitalisation, and finance. Discussions will explore the opportunities and challenges associated with strengthening regional connectivity, improving trade and transport links, advancing digital solutions, and mobilising the investment and financing required for infrastructure and connectivity projects.

The Conference will bring together senior representatives from the public and private sectors, international financial institutions, and relevant stakeholders from Azerbaijan and Germany, creating a platform for strategic exchange and identifying opportunities for deeper bilateral and regional cooperation.

The programme will consist of two main parts. The first part will feature high-level panel discussions bringing together representatives of business, government, and international financial institutions to address the strategic dimensions of connectivity along the Middle Corridor. The second part will focus on the practical dimension of cooperation through B2G roundtable discussions, allowing businesses to engage directly with relevant public institutions, present their priorities and challenges, and discuss potential solutions and areas for cooperation.

The 2026 German–Azerbaijan Strategic Partnership and Connectivity Conference is intended to contribute to the promotion and implementation of the priority areas identified in the Joint Declaration on the Strategic Agenda for the Bilateral Partnership between the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Federal Republic of Germany, signed in Berlin on 21 July 2026. In this context, the Conference will serve as an important platform for strengthening sustainable dialogue and cooperation among public institutions, the private sector, and international partners, while supporting the development of concrete opportunities for bilateral economic cooperation and connectivity along the Middle Corridor.
